

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION FROM SCHOOL-SPONSORED OFF-CAMPUS
ACTIVITIES

- I. If the District provides transportation to a student enrolled in the District to a school-sponsored, off-campus meeting, activity or event, the District must provide return transportation for that student to the original point of departure or to an appropriate school in the district, unless:
 - a. The student's parent/legal guardian signs the student out of the off-campus meeting, activity or event, or
 - b. The student's parent or legal guardian provides the District with advanced written authorization to release the student to another person who has agreed to assume the responsibility of providing the student with return transportation.

- II. If the District is obligated to provide a student enrolled in the District with return transportation pursuant to this policy, but intervening circumstances make such return transportation impractical, a representative of the school district will remain with the student until:
 - a. The student's parent or legal guardian has been contacted and informed of the intervening circumstances making the return transportation impractical, and
 - b. The student has been delivered to his or her parent or legal guardian.
