

## HOME SCHOOLING CO-CURRICULAR PARTICIPATION

- I. It is the policy of the Waterville Central School District Board of Education that students approved by the District for Home Schooling will be allowed to participate in District sponsored co-curricular activities.
- II. Co-curricular activities are identified in the Contract with the WTA and listed in the appropriate student handbooks. NYSED Regulations state home schooled students are not eligible to participate in Inter-Scholastic Athletics.
- III. In order to participate, home schooled students must comply with eligibility regulations as defined in the current Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct & Eligibility Policy and Regulation.
- IV. The Co-Curricular Activity: Acknowledgement and Consent Regulation #7300.1 must be completed and returned for all Co-curricular activities.
- V. For the purposes of pupil insurance coverage, all home schooled students will be considered students of the Waterville Central School District.
- VI. Application packet for home schooled students to participate in Co-Curricular Activities at Waterville Central School shall include:
  - Enrollment/Emergency Information Card
  - Health History Update/Including Immunizations
  - Emergency Medical Information
  - Co-Curricular Code of Conduct (to be signed and returned)
  - Student Activity Eligibility Policy (as per policy – students failing an academic course – student names should be submitted to the MS/HS Guidance Office)
- VII. Parents are responsible for submitting the appropriate forms prior to a student beginning participation in the activity.
