

## STUDENT HOMEWORK

- I. The district recognizes, and research shows that homework is one of many instructional tools that can support student learning. Thoughtful homework is work the student is able to complete independently for the purpose of practice, reinforcement and review; preparation for new learning; assessing student progress toward achieving proficiency; and communication between those at home and those at school.
  
- II. The Superintendent of Schools shall develop regulations to assure that district homework practices support student learning. District regulations shall specify the means by which students and parents/guardians shall be informed regarding homework expectations, the relationship of homework to the student's grades, the role of parents/guardians regarding homework, and school resources to assist students with homework.
