One of the primary functions of the Ethics Commission is to investigate Complaints alleging a violation of the Town's Code of Ethics. Upon receipt of any properly filed Complaint (the filing rules are on the town's website) the Commission conducts an inquiry to decide whether there is probable cause to believe a violation of the code has occurred, warranting further investigation. Confidentiality at the preliminary stage is necessary to protect the privacy of officials, employees, and citizens. As a result, as specified by the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes §§ 1-200(6) and 1-206, all information supplied to or received by the Commission during the evaluation and investigation remains confidential. If the agenda indicates that a Complaint is scheduled for review, any discussion about the substance of the allegations will take place in Executive Session. Any resulting decisions will be announced, if feasible, after the Executive Session concludes. Moreover, under its rules, the Commission may dismiss the complaint, with the grounds for dismissal set forth, while continuing to protect the identity of both the respondent and the complainant.)
