**Responsibilities:** The Lower School Art Teacher will report to the Head of Lower School and will assume responsibility for instructing art classes for students in grades TK-1. The teacher will be accountable for fostering an engaging classroom environment and for assessing and reporting student progress. The instructor must also utilize a variety of pedagogical approaches to cultivate a passion for the visual arts in all students. The teacher is expected to collaborate effectively with other members of the LS faculty as well as department members. The teacher should demonstrate an integral personal and professional commitment to cultural competence and a robust dedication to leadership, learning, and teaching within a diverse community. Candidates are expected to

proactively pursue professional and intellectual growth, seeking out conferences, courses, and other opportunities for continuous learning. This role will serve as lead teacher when the other LS Art teacher is absent and will also assist the other LS Art teacher on projects as needed. In addition to standard teaching duties, the candidate's participation will be required for non-classroom responsibilities, which may include but are not limited to lunch duty, recess supervision, and carpool assistance.

**Qualifications:** An ideal candidate for this position holds a bachelor's degree in art or art education as well as three or more years of elementary teaching experience. The candidate demonstrates a strong understanding of the Elements of Art and Principles of Design; as well as experience using and teaching a variety of art media and techniques (drawing, painting, printmaking, mixed media, and sculpture/ceramics) with an understanding of art history. They foster a positive, well-managed studio environment that encourages creativity, risk-taking, and confidence as they assess student learning through thoughtful growth-focused feedback. A strong academic background in verbal and written communication skills and proficient technology experience is essential. The candidate should also demonstrate the ability to work effectively as a team member in order to collaborate with colleagues, communicate effectively with families, and contribute to school events.
