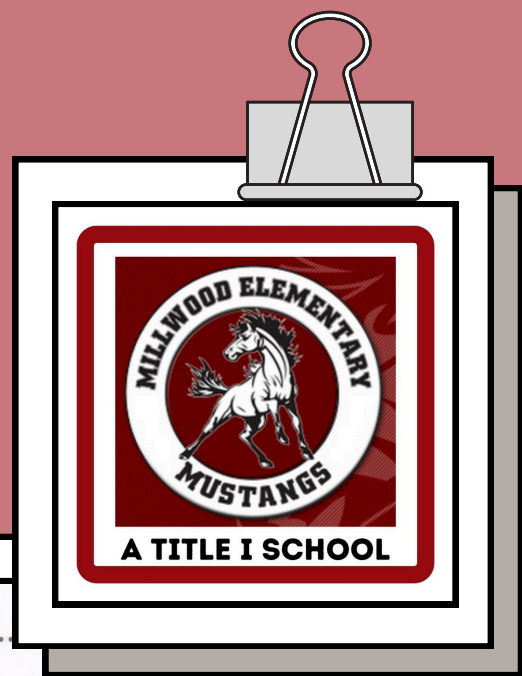


Millwood NEWS

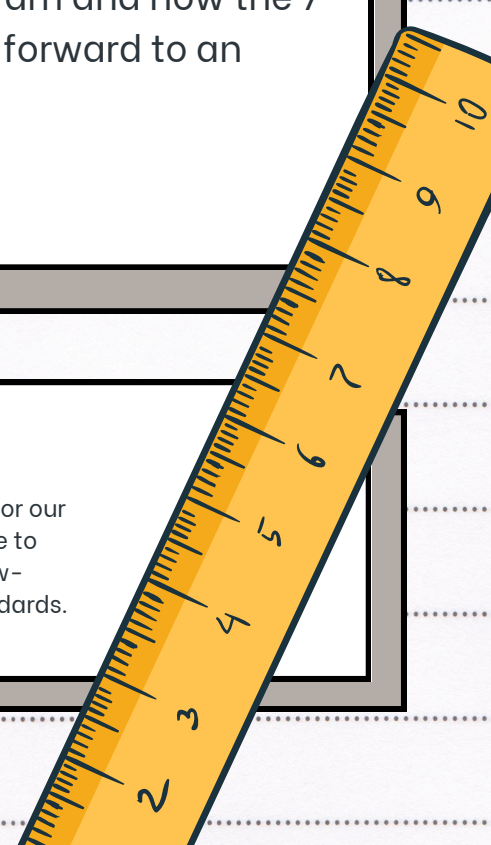

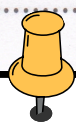

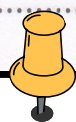
