### BEHAVIOR

All Senior activities are official school activities. Any student in violation of the law or school policy can be suspended and/or turned over to the police, may face possible legal charges, and will have his/her diploma held pending disciplinary action. Senior Banquet is an event for members of the Southmoore Senior Class ONLY. (Parents, teachers, underclassmen and students from other schools may not attend.) Senior Banquet includes a catered dinner, entertainment, the Senior Video, and presentation of the Senior Awards.

**The Senior Banquet is a semi-formal affair.**

Students are required to wear either slacks, dress shirt and tie; or a dress, blouse/skirt, or pantsuit. All outfits must be appropriate and modest. Slips should be worn with sheer dresses. Shorts/rompers of any kind are not appropriate. NO bare midriffs. **NO jeans**.

## GRADUATION PRACTICE

### GRADUATION PRACTICE IS REQUIRED!!!

SEATS WILL BE ASSIGNED FOR GRADUATION AT PRACTICE. You must attend the practice if you plan to participate in the commencement ceremony. Graduation is an optional activity, but if you choose to participate, you **MUST ATTEND PRACTICE** and abide by ALL RULES. Any exceptions require administrative approval by the Senior Principal.

Graduation Practice is REQUIRED. Students not attending practice will have their name removed and will NOT be allowed to participate at the Graduation Ceremony.

At Practice, final seating assignments will be made and instruction will be given as to how the procession will occur and how diplomas will be distributed.

## COMMENCEMENT/GRADUATION

**Monday, May 18, 2026 at 6:30 PM**

**Lloyd Noble Center** (2900 S Jenkins Ave, Norman, OK)

Admission to graduation is *FREE*. Gates will open at 5:00PM. Noise makers are not allowed. The LNC has a strict Clear Bag Policy and all guests will be required to pass through metal detectors upon entrance. Go to the Senior Canvas module or the Senior Class Website for more information.

Seniors are to be in place **no later than 5:45 PM** **in proper dress** and with their cap and gown.

**Graduation Name Announcement** - A piece of paper will be provided at graduation for you to write your name on. Write your name the way you would like it announced as you cross the stage to receive your diploma cover. Inappropriate names or language on your name card will result in your name not being announced. Remember, you have worked many years for this moment. Do not do anything to embarrass your family or jeopardize this public recognition of your effort.

**Graduation Dress** - All Seniors are required to conform to one of the two dress options.

**Option 1** – Cap & Gown with a collared dress shirt, tie, dress slacks, and dress shoes.

**Option 2** – Cap & Gown with the white graduation gown collar attached to the gown, and wear a dress, or blouse and skirt or nice slacks, and dress shoes.

All students must wear dress shoes. **No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, backless shoes or tennis shoes will be allowed.** Wedges are fine.

You are to wear the cap that goes with your graduation gown along with the **Navy & Gold Southmoore** tassel which is worn on the right side of the cap. **No other items may be attached to the cap.** You may NOT decorate your cap. You may want to bring bobby pins to secure your cap.

Only school approved regalia (cords, stoles, etc.) may be worn on the gown.

**Students failing to meet dress code will not be allowed to participate in Graduation/Commencement.**

**Graduation Mask Policy** - Masks are optional at Graduation. If a Graduate chooses to wear a mask, it **MUST** be a single, solid color. NO patterns, designs, logos, lettering or wording is allowed on your mask. The only exception to this is the official Southmoore school logo which may be on your mask. Students wearing an inappropriate mask will have their mask removed and be given a district approved mask.
