Students enrolled in advanced should expect more in-depth classroom discussions and overall greater academic expectations on assignments and time management. These classes are clustered with GT and non-GT students. All MPVA teachers are GT-certified.</p>	<p>The curriculum is further accelerated and enriched by the teachers. This program is provided for identified students who tested and scored at a qualifying level. Students enrolled in these classes should expect to complete rigorous inquiry base assignments and projects.</p>


