




Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District

Special Education Demographics:

As of Dec. 2, 2025, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows 388 students receiving Special Education (up from 385 in November), with an additional 3 Referrals and 13 Consents for Evaluation. By comparison, Edplan showed that 361 students received Special Education in November of last year.

Department Projects:

2025-2026 General Supervision File Review

The department has received notification that the **2025-2026 General Supervision File Review**, led by the **State Special Education Department**, will start soon.

- The State will be requesting **three randomly selected student files** for review this year to monitor compliance with state and federal regulations, particularly the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
- This audit process typically requires internal work and is generally completed in the spring.

Federal Changes to General Supervision Structure

In addition to the state review, the **Office of Special Education (OSEP)** at the federal level has been collaborating with the state of Idaho on the **overall structure and process of General Supervision**.

- We are anticipating **changes to our local requirements** and compliance monitoring processes as a direct result of these shifting federal guidelines. The state has recently been working on revisions to the Idaho Special Education Manual and addressing OSEP's inquiries.
