Requirements

CLASSES:

Six or more semesters of Visual and or Performing Arts (Two main stage musical productions equal a semester class.)

EXTRA CURRICULAR*:

Membership for at least two years in one or more of the following: Dance Company, Jazba, Folklorico, Spontaneous Combustion, International Thespian Society, A Cappella, Tri-M Music Honor Society, Cast/Crew for Presentation Theater, VPA Internship, National Arts Honor Society

COMMUNITY/CAREER:

*Attend at least one event listed below per semester:

- Presentation Dance performance
- Presentation Theater performance
- Presentation Music performance
- Art Showcase at Presentation
- Professional art exhibitions
- Professional theater shows
- Professional concerts
- Submit to a visual or performing art contest

SERVICE:

*Participate in VPA sponsored service or outreach events at least once per year

- Set Build/Tear Down of Presentation Theater Productions
- Help run a Presentation Visual Art Exhibition
- Jury for *Boundless* Presentation's Art and Lit magazine
