

Registering for Courses in Infinite Campus 2026-2027

1. Login to your Infinite Campus student portal.
2. Your Infinite Campus account uses your student number as the username and your microsoft/computer password.
3. On the left toolbar, select, "Academic Plan".
4. Select Post Grad Location, select Post Grad Plans, click next (this is just a plan, we know plans can change).
5. Your job is to select courses for the Freshman year only.
6. Click the box for that subject area (ex. English) and type the course you'd like to take.
7. Remember to select A and B courses to match (A being 1st semester and B being 2nd semester)
8. Repeat this for each subject area (Math, Science, Social Studies, Electives, Fine Arts, PE, World Language, etc.
9. Once your 6 Freshman courses are built, click save.

Counselors will be at Payne on 1/12 and San Tan on 1/13 to talk with students about the registration process.

They will return to Payne on 1/27 and San Tan on 1/30 to answer any questions and pick up Academic Plan print outs.


AMS (current 8th grade AMS students) registration will take place on 2/2.
