COMMUNITY INVITED FOR SELF-GUIDED TOURS OF HISTORIC HORACE MANN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AHEAD OF NEXT YEAR’S DEMOLITION

Horace Mann Elementary School’s administration is inviting the community for another opportunity to bid farewell to a school that has served students in Fargo for more than a century.

Horace Mann Elementary School is inviting the community to come take a walk down memory lane inside the historic building, opened in 1915, before it is demolished following the completion of this school year. The building is scheduled to be open to the community for self-guided tours next Monday, December 29 from 5-8 p.m.

In addition to next week’s opportunity, the building is scheduled to be open to the community on two more dates before the end of the school year:

- Saturday, April 11: noon-4 p.m.
- Wednesday, May 13: 5:30-8 p.m.

The Horace Mann Elementary School building is scheduled to be demolished following the conclusion of this school year to make way for a new elementary school on its grounds as part of Fargo Public Schools’ Long-Range Facility Plan.

The Fargo Board of Education approved moving forward with the design and planning phases for a new elementary school located at the current Horace Mann Elementary School site. The project calls for the construction of a new, centrally located, three-section elementary school that will have the capacity to serve approximately 444 students in grades K–5. Once completed, this new school will bring together the Horace Mann–Roosevelt and Madison Elementary School attendance areas into a single, unified school community.
