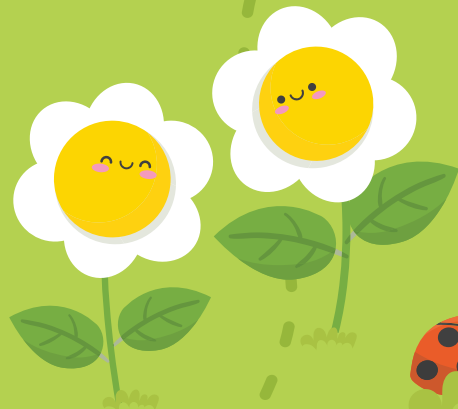

ENROLLMENT & REGISTRATION

- Enrollment is available to Chandler families through CampBrain.
- Registration must be completed online prior to attendance, including for drop-in days.
- Space in Enrichment Classes is limited and filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Waitlists will be created for full classes and families will be notified if space becomes available.

PROGRAM HOURS & LATE PICK-UP

- Extended Care is open Monday - Friday 2:00 - 6:00 p.m.
- Parents who pick up 15 minutes after the hour will be charged the \$30 per hour drop-in rate.

PROGRAM CHANGES

- The School reserves the right to adjust schedules, staffing or class offerings as needed.
- Parents will be notified promptly of any significant program changes.

REFUNDS & BILLING

- Refunds are not issued for missed days due to illness, vacation or schedule changes. If a refund is approved, it will be applied as a credit to the family's account for future use in CEC programs.

- Note: All families must register for the drop-in program as part of the registration process.


UNLIMITED PLANS

Plans allow for unlimited use of the program throughout the Spring Session dates and includes participation in CEC Activities and Homework Lab. In the Homework Lab, students are guided by CEC staff and Chandler faculty to complete their assignments. After completion, students have access to a variety of CEC activities.

CEC Activities are led by the CEC team. Spring Session activity themes involve academic skill building, play and well-being, and community connection. While many CEC options will be available daily to offer flexibility and options to students, parents may also enroll students into Enrichment Classes for a separate registration fee. ACTING FOR SCREEN [3-8]

Step onto your mark and into the world of on-camera performance. In Acting for Screen students will discover what it takes to bring characters to life for film and television. Each week, they'll learn essential on-camera skills such as hitting marks, maintaining eyelines, finding their light, and delivering natural, believable performances. Through scene work, audition exercises, and short filmed projects, students will build confidence in front of the camera while exploring everything from commercial copy to dramatic dialogue. This class emphasizes collaboration, listening, and truthful acting—giving students the tools they need to feel at ease on set or in an audition room. Along the way, they'll gain a deeper understanding of how a film set operates and how actors fit into the larger creative process. No prior acting experience is required—just a willingness to take risks, have fun, and tell great stories.
