

IS 162 – CEP GOALS 2025–2026

Priority 1 – All students learn to read well

By June, 2026, literacy for All Students will improve, as measured by a 15% increase, from 32% to 47% of students scoring at or above proficiency on the NYS ELA exam results.

Priority 2 – All students are physically and emotionally safe

By June, 2026, physical and mental wellness for All Students will improve, as measured by a 10% increase in Preventing Bullying, from 61% to 71% as measured by the NYC School Survey results and internal SEL reflections/check-ins.

Priority 3 – All students have a high-quality academic experience

By June, 2026, reading proficiency for all English Language Learners will improve, as measured by a 15% increase, from 0% to 15% of students scoring at or above proficiency on the I-Ready EOY diagnostic.

Priority 4 – All students graduate college and career ready and have a strong plan and pathway to economic security

By June, 2026, the 8th grade students' proficiency in math for All Students will increase by 15% from 13% to 28% as measured by Algebra 1 Regents.

Priority 5 – All districts and schools are more inclusive and responsive for parents and families, including having more families choose NYC Public Schools

By June, 2026, the percentage of parents/families attending in-person events will increase by 1% from 4% to 5% as measured by attendance sign-in sheets.
