

## **PLEASANT HILL MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS JANUARY 9, 2026**

The new cell phone and personal electronic device policy is now in place in alignment with Oregon Executive Order 25-09, which requires all Oregon schools to limit student device use during instructional hours.

What this means for students at PHMS/HS:

From 8:19 a.m. to 3:10 p.m., all cell phones and electronic devices must be turned OFF and put AWAY.

- Devices may not be kept in pockets, hands, or on desks.
- Devices must be stored in a backpack or locker for the entire school day.
- There is no device use during passing periods, lunch, or class time.

This policy is designed to support student engagement, reduce distractions, and strengthen the learning environment for all students.
