On Friday, January 23, all kindergarten classes will go to the Millibo Art Theatre to see Suitcase Fairy Tales. Children will ride the bus provided by our school district.

**All children (AM & PM) come in the morning. No afternoon kindergarten class.**

- Please have your child go to the bathroom before school.
- Drop off is at 8:05am or 8:30am. We will have two classes of students in the classroom. Tutors will not be available after 8:12. If you arrive after 8:12, please park and walk your child into the school.
- We will take attendance at 8:30. We will leave school at 9:00.
- **Do not bring backpacks, water bottles or snacks. Snack and water will be provided.**
- Children wear their regular uniforms.
- **Buses will return by 11:30am. Please bring your carpool sign, park and walk up to the turf area to pick up your child.** We will have over 100 students to release. Please be aware that if the buses return late, 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be in the carpool line.
- **Due to limited space at the theatre, we will not have parent chaperones. Please partner with us by having a conversation with your child about appropriate behavior in a theatre. **Permission slips are due by 1/15.****

**Reminder:** We have PE on Thursdays. Please remember to send your child to school in PE shoes. We do not have time for students to change their shoes. They will not be able to participate in PE if appropriate shoes are not worn.
