Prompt:

Write a short essay to describe how you have met the five core values of National Junior Honor Society: scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship. Pick at least 3 of those values to discuss in your essay (you may use all 5). Provide examples and stories of times you have shown these characteristics.

Requirements:

- Type your essay in 12-point font
- Minimum of 250 words and maximum of 750 words
- Include word count at the end of essay
- Essay is a Google Doc
- Link to essay is included with online application (make sure to give Mrs. Fast viewing or commenting privileges when you share it)
- Title of Google Doc includes your first and last name. Example:
HannahFastNJHSEssay

Note: This essay is only required for new members. If you were inducted into NJHS at Leota in a previous year you do not need to complete this essay again.

Example Essay:

Being accepted for membership in the National Junior Honor Society would be a great honor. I often become a head of many activities, such as staging plays or organizing segments for the Leota Lion Channel. My personal character traits help me to gain the trust and respect of my peers as they believe me to be an open-minded and dependable person. I have learned to solve problems and conflicts in a positive way, and I am always ready to assist my peers when it is needed.
