Scholarship eligibility requires student to be a graduating senior in the Keller Independent School District with the intention of using the scholarship within one year. To avoid forfeiture, *scholarship must be used by June 30, 2027*, unless prior special concessions have been made in writing.

*The Greater Keller Women's Club Foundation*, a 501 C-3 tax exempt entity, was established in 1996. This Foundation raises funds through generous donations from GKWC, proceeds from The Garden of Roses Fashion Show & Fundraiser, proceeds from The Bowden Events & Weddings, along with private donations to GKWCF. These funds are directed to our Northeast Tarrant County community with grants to local nonprofit organizations as well as a scholarship program benefiting KISD High School Students. Over the last 30 years, the Foundation has had the privilege to donate more than \$2.7 million dollars into the community.

The Garden of Roses Fashion Show & Fundraiser, our annual fundraiser will be held at The Bowden Events & Weddings in Keller, Texas on March 20, 2026, with the help of over 200 club members.
