## A peek at our week:

ELA	Heggerty: Rhyme recognition, onset fluency, blending words, isolating final sounds, segmenting words, adding words, deleting words, substituting words and language awareness. Phonics: Decoding and encoding cvc words. Heart words: look, I, see, red, three, two, be, yellow, me, we, it, and, one, the, a, at Comprehension: main characters, setting, plot
PURPOSEFUL PLAY CENTERS	This week the theme was "snow." We turned the dramatic play center into an ice rink! At the block center, students created winter scenes. If only we had real snow!
MATH	Unit 5: In this unit, students explore different ways to compose and decompose numbers within 10 and to represent the compositions and decompositions. Special attention is given to composing and decomposing 10, as it is the basis of place value in our number system. To support their reasoning, students use their fingers and a 10-frame—created by putting together two 5-frames
CHARACTER STRONG	Our Character Strong trait this month is <b>Perseverance: is pushing yourself to work through challenges and obstacles.</b>
