SUMMIT, IL, January 9, 2026 (eRelease) - Argo Community High School is proud to announce that 46 seniors from the Class of 2026 have been named Illinois State Scholars, marking the largest number of Illinois State Scholars at Argo Community High School in at least the past decade.

The **Illinois State Scholar** designation is awarded annually by the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) to Illinois high school seniors who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement. Students are selected based on a combination of criteria, including SAT and/or ACT scores, class rank at the conclusion of their junior year, and overall academic performance. Illinois State Scholars represent approximately the top ten percent of graduating seniors statewide, making this recognition one of the state's most prestigious academic honors

This record-setting accomplishment reflects the dedication and academic excellence of Argo students, as well as the continued commitment of student families and the district's faculty and staff. The district is extremely proud of both its students and staff for achieving this milestone.
