Arrival, Dismissal

REMINDEERS

Car Riders - All parents must have a car rider placard to pick up any student from our line. Students will be called to their cars during dismissal using their name/grade. Car riders are defined as children whose parents remain in the car throughout the drop off and pick up procedures. Please do not park or drop off from the street. Please be courteous while in our car rider line, arriving at the correct number is directly related to merging the way you are instructed to by Cockrell staff. Car traffic is heavy and unpredictable at arrival and dismissal time making it very unsafe.

- **Car Rider Arrival**-Car riders can be dropped off in the **front driveway beginning at 7:15 AM**. Do not drop students earlier than 7:15 AM, there is no supervision for your child before this time. We have a lot of car riders at Cockrell. **To avoid long lines, we recommend arriving prior to 7:40 AM. If your child is tardy (after 7:55 AM) please park and walk your child into the school building.**
- **Car Rider Dismissal** - A car rider placard must be shown to the staff member calling names. Cars that do not have the Cockrell placard will be asked to park and come in to the building to show ID.

Walkers/Bike Riders - Walkers and bike riders are defined as children who walk /ride their bikes to and from school property and home. Walkers and bike riders are to stay on the sidewalks at all times. Parents should not park across the street from the school or in neighborhoods and have students walk to their cars. **Pre-K and Kinder students must have an adult waiting to receive them after crossing the driveway.**

- **Walkers/Bike Rider Arrival**- Students eating breakfast should arrive between 7:15 and 7:45 AM. Bike riders must park their bike on the bike rack located inside the fence near the hardtop.
- **Walker/Bike Rider Dismissal**- Walkers and bike riders will be dismissed before our car riders begin loading. Students will be walked along the sidewalk that leads to Old Alvin Rd. All walkers and bike riders grades 1-4 will be released regardless if there is an adult present. **Pre-K and kinder students must have an adult to meet them. **Parents will wait for students on the neighborhood sidewalk or the Old Alvin sidewalk across from the school. We are asking that parents do not cross the street or driveway and allow our teachers and crossing guard to cross students.**

Bus Transportation - The opportunity to ride a Pearland ISD school bus is a privilege and certain expectations for appropriate conduct have been established to ensure the safety of all the students. Parents will be notified of any student who does not follow the bus rules. Students are allowed to ride their regular bus only. They may not ride home with a friend.

Students in Pre-K and Kindergarten will only be released from the bus to an approved adult using their child's unique PIN# provided by the parents at the time of registration.

January 12th



LOCKDOWN: LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

Why: Lockdown is called when there is a threat or hazard inside the school building. From parental custody disputes to intruders to a weapon on campus, LOCKDOWN uses classroom security to protect students and staff from threat.

Tuesday
January 13th



HOLD: In your room or area. Clear the halls.

Why: Hold is called when the need when hallways and common areas need to be kept clear of occupants. Sometimes called when dealing with a medical emergency.

Wednesday
January 14th



EVACUATION: FIRE! To designated location.

Why: Evacuation is called to move students and staff from one location to another. (Ex: Fire alarm has sounded).

Thursday
January 15th



SHELTER: SHELTER! Hazard or Weather

Why: Shelter is called when the need for personal protection is necessary. Training should include spontaneous events such as hazmat or weather.
