CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents and guardians agree to:

- Make sure their child arrives at school on time, in uniform and properly equipped;
- Make sure their child is collected on time by an authorised adult known to the child and school
- Inform the school of any absence;
- Avoid all unnecessary absences, including holidaying in school time;
- Inform the school of any concerns or worries that may be affecting their child's learning or behaviour;
 - Support their child's participation in all areas of the curriculum;
 - Encourage and support home learning;
 - Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour;
 - Encourage their child to treat everyone with respect at all times;
 - Support the school's actions with respect to their child's conduct and behaviour, including sanctions if necessary;
- Attend parent teacher consultations as well as other meetings about their child's progress;
- Keep track of the school calendar, events and other relevant information provided by the school;
- Read school communication and reply as requested;
- Communicate with the school, staff and parent community, in a constructive and respectful manner;
- Provide up to date contact details;
- Observe the safety and security procedures operated by the school.
