### SAT ASSESSMENT

QSI Yerevan offers the PSAT for students of Secondary I, II, III, and IV. This allows students to know their strengths and weaknesses for when they take the SAT. The SAT is the entrance exam used by US universities to make admission decisions.

All scores from the class of 2025, including non-native English speakers, are included. QSI International School of Yerevan median SAT score: English 530 and Math 644.

# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The school offers four diplomas.

**Academic Diploma with Honors:** 240 QSI Unit Credits (24 Carnegie units)  
Requirements are the same as the Academic Diploma, with the added condition that accumulated credits include at least two Advanced Placement (AP) courses. A total of 240 credits is required for this diploma.

**AP Capstone Diploma:** AP Seminar and AP Research with four other AP scores of 3 or better.

# ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) CLASSES

Advanced placement (AP) allow high school students to challenge themselves by taking classes with a rigor similar to college classes. In 2024, 82% of secondary students took AP exams and scored 3 or better.

# GRADING

Mastery of each essential unit is evaluated with an A or B (mastery grades). "B" denotes mastery of learning outcomes at a high level of understanding. "A" represents mastery where the student demonstrates higher-order thinking skills. Mediocre or poor work, resulting in Cs and Ds, is not acceptable, and students will re-engage until they demonstrate mastery. Students who master a unit with a B evaluation may attempt to demonstrate a higher level of mastery at a later time, within that current school year, to change the evaluation to an A. Time periods (quarters, semesters, and terms) are not evaluated. Assessment is continuous and student performance is assessed on learning outcomes and units of study.
