The Academy of Engineering and Technology at South Paulding High School is a college preparatory program for students interested in math, science, and engineering. The standards and expectations for attending the school are detailed in specific conduct and academic achievement guidelines. These standards are outlined in this contract.

Please read carefully. The student and parent must initial each expectation and sign below.

- _____ 1. I will attend school daily, arrive promptly, and remain throughout the scheduled hours.
- _____ 2. I will cooperate with the faculty and staff of South Paulding High School, my peers, liaison personnel, and community partners conducting myself in a respectful manner.
- _____ 3. I understand that if I have not already completed Algebra Concepts as an 8th grader, I am committing to complete both Honors Algebra Concepts and Honors Geometry Concepts during my freshman year.
- _____ 4. I will successfully complete all classwork, homework, and assignments to meet standards.
- _____ 5. I will successfully complete my program of study including three Engineering courses as my pathway.
- _____ 6. I will set aside a minimum of one hour of uninterrupted study time daily.
- _____ 7. I will maintain a minimum grade of 80 (weighted) in all AIM required courses. In addition, I will maintain a grade of at least 70 in all other courses. Grades will be monitored and analyzed each grading period. Failure to meet this criterion will result in probation and if not corrected may result in removal of the student from the program and reassignment of the student to their home school (if school choice).
- _____ 8. I will maintain the highest standards of honesty and integrity and will abide by the rules and regulations of the SPHS student handbook and the Paulding County Board of Education code of student conduct and discipline. Repeated discipline incidents may result in withdrawal from the program.
- _____ 9. I will not be allowed to leave the Academy midyear. I will not seek readmission to the Academy if I am withdrawn for any reason.
- _____ 10. I will actively participate in TSA (Technology Student Association), the organization associated with the engineering career pathway and school. I will pay my membership dues each year.
- _____ 11. I understand that I will be following a specific AIM program class schedule which may limit some other course selections. (Band, Chorus, Theater, JROTC, ...)
- _____ 12. Our pass/fail policy for the AIM Academy allows a student to fail one Academy class with the condition they retake and pass the exact same course the following semester. Once a student fails two Academy classes, they will be removed from the program.

The privilege of attending the Academy of Engineering and Technology depends upon the personal responsibility, commitment, and dedication of both the student and the parent. I understand and agree to adhere to the standards and expectations of this contract. Failure to meet any of the above criteria may result in immediate removal from the program. This contract will be upheld as long as the student remains in the program.
