

SchoolHouse Connection Scholarship Program

Helping you get to and through higher education

Our scholarship provides financial assistance, intensive case management, peer support, and leadership opportunities for students who have experienced homelessness to help you get to and through college, build your career, and create a strong foundation for your future.

WHAT YOU'LL RECEIVE:

- \$2500 and monthly stipends of up to \$100
- One-on-one support from staff and scholars
- Three all-expenses-paid trips: awards ceremony celebration in Orlando, FL, advocacy trip to Washington, DC, and a wellness and workforce success retreat
- Opportunities to engage in local, state, and national advocacy

WHO CAN APPLY?

- You currently reside in the United States. (Undocumented applicants are eligible.)
- You were born on or after June 2, 2007.
- You will be starting college for the first time (not including dual-enrollment) in the 2027–2028 academic year at a four-year college or university, community college, or trade school. This includes:
 - High school juniors
 - High school seniors planning to take a gap year
 - Students earning a GED who will start college in 2027–2028
- You have experienced homelessness within the last six years.

Our program begins working with students one year before they start college to provide intensive college readiness support.
