EASTCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL

Located in Westchester County, nestled between the Hutchinson River and the Bronx River, the Eastchester community was settled in 1664. The Eastchester Union Free School District was incorporated formally in 1892 and has since been serving its community of professionals, tradesmen and executives through innovative teaching design and a strong focus on the whole child.

Eastchester High School is a four-year comprehensive school program with an academic curriculum that has been nationally recognized for its excellence by the U.S. Department of Education. The majority of students enroll in a four-year college preparatory program, with others pursuing associates degrees, military service or employment. Students are offered numerous opportunities to participate in Advanced Placement (AP) and dual enrollment courses in all content areas, as well as an Advanced Science Research program and the W.I.S.E. internship program. A wide array of extracurricular clubs and athletic opportunities, as well as winter and spring concerts and theater/dance productions to showcase student talent outside of the classroom, round out the EHS student experience. The Eastchester community supports a strong emphasis on community service and content-specific field trips, both nationally and internationally, that broaden the students' understanding of the connection between the curriculum and an increasingly important global perspective.

- ◆ Eastchester High School has an award-winning research program. In the 2024–2025 academic year, students earned 2nd and 3rd place at the WESEF competition. Notable student accomplishments include the selection of two students for prestigious Regeneron mentorships and the publication of research by two students—one in the Journal of Emerging Investigators and another in Clinical Nutrition ESPEN.

- ◆ In 2024-2025, 20 students competed in the NYS School Music Association competition. Six Students participated in Westchester County Area All State.
- ◆ In 2024-2025 EHS Player's Club, a student theatrical program, earned 8 Metro Award nominations. A member of the class of 2025 won the Metro Award for Best Featured Actor in a Musical

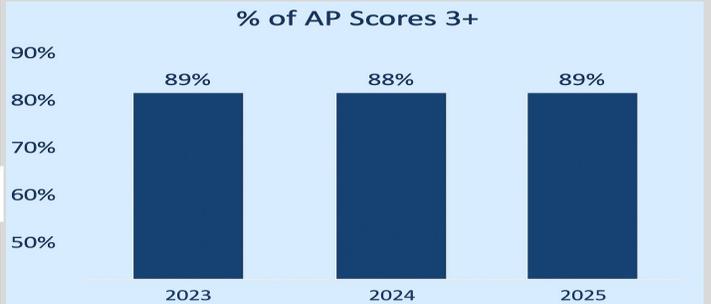
