

## The Compact & Plan

## Home-School Partnership

**Families have a right to be involved in their child's education. At Jenifer Elementary, we will:**

- Hold an annual meeting to discuss the Title I program, and collect your feedback on the spending of Title I funds and the 1% family engagement budget.
- Educate school staff on how to work with parents as equal partners in their child's educational process.
- Show families how to monitor their child's progress.
- Provide materials/training to help families work with their child to improve their academic achievement.
- Assist families with understanding State academic standards and State/local academic assessments.
- Maintain a Family Resource Center.
- Hold meetings and family engagement events at times that are convenient for families.
- Encourage families to volunteer and join our school's Title I DADvisory Council, PTO and/or School Improvement Team.
- Offer childcare when applicable.
- Utilize interpreters and document translation services so families can receive information in a language they understand.
- Provide full opportunities for the participation of parents with limited English proficiency, with disabilities, and of migratory children.
- Coordinate and integrate family engagement programs and activities with other Federal, State, and local programs.

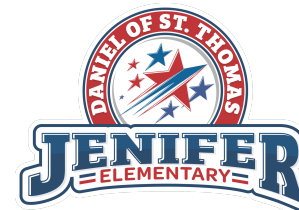
