ALL tuition payments are processed through **FACTS Tuition Management**. Tuition is pro-rated quarterly for all mid-year admissions. Needs based financial aid is available for students in Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Fees are in addition to Tuition and due/payable as follows:

| Application Fee | <p>NEW Families: This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid at the time of initial application.</p> <p>CURRENT Families: The New Sibling Application Fee will be credited to the family account if the admissions application is submitted no later than 12/15/25 <u>and</u> the new sibling's enrollment is finalized.</p> | <p>\$150/First Student \$50/Each Sibling <i>due with application</i></p> |
| Enrollment Fee | <p>This <i>nonrefundable fee</i> is paid yearly and is due at the time of enrollment/re-enrollment. This fee pays for yearly account administrative functions and also holds the student's class placement.</p> <p>NEW Families: New Student Application must be submitted by February 1 to receive PRIORITY enrollment fee discount of \$250 (for new families enrolling a first child in grades K-12). Applications received after February 1 and on or before May 1, will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p> <p>CURRENT Families: ALL re-enrollment steps must be complete by March 2 to receive a \$250 PRIORITY discount off of the enrollment fee. Re-enrollment completed after March 2 and on or before May 1 will receive a \$100 enrollment fee discount.</p> | <p>\$550/Family <i>\$250 PRIORITY discount by Priority Deadline</i> <i>\$100 discount by May 1</i> due upon enrollment/re-enrollment</p> |
| Enhancement Fee | By volunteering in the school community beginning June 1, 2026 through May 31, 2027, this yearly fee is reimbursed to the family's account at the rate of \$15 per volunteer hour. | <p>\$150/Family <i>due upon enrollment/re-enrollment</i></p> |
| *Student Fee | NOW INCLUDED IN TUITION! This <i>nonrefundable yearly fee</i> covers the cost of student yearbook, ASB ID card, admission to home sporting events, emergency preparedness materials, campus security and required standardized testing expenses. This fee is also used to cover expenses for classroom supplements, co-curricular programs, the high school annual retreat, costs related to school spirit and student life activities and subsidizes grade specific field trips. | <p><i>included in tuition</i></p> |
| Chromebooks | <i>Phased in requirement.</i> All 9 th and 10 th grade students for the 2026-27 school year are required to use a school issued Chromebook. Students promoting from RCS Middle School have the option of keeping their <u>school-issued</u> Chromebook or may order a new one. Orders open in May and must be submitted no later than July 20. <i>*Estimate based on market pricing.</i> | <p>*\$500/Chromebook</p> |
| Textbooks | Upper school students are responsible for purchasing their own books either from other students or from online sources. The amount of purchase depends on the student's class schedule and where the books are purchased. The school's booklist, published in the summer, will highlight several books that are available for rent through the school. | <p>Varies</p> |
| Athletic Fees | There are no additional fees for sports, however, there may be expenses for spirit packs and uniforms. PE Uniforms are required for all students in PE classes. One (1) PE Uniform is included in tuition. Additional PE Uniforms may be purchased for \$20/set. | <p>*PE Uniform <i>included in tuition</i></p> |
| Miscellaneous Fees/Costs | Additional costs include split financial accounts, special instructional supplies, replacement locks, band/choir attire, choir tour, instrument rental and damage deposit, SOAR, yearbook convention, expenses relating to field trips and class trips, AP exams, class pictures, graduation, and special events. There is an additional cost for students who require an aide as part of their Special Education services; that cost is dependent upon the percentage of time an aide is required. | <p>Varies</p> |
