ANNUAL STUDENT OUTCOME GOAL: BY JUNE 4TH, 2026, 6TH - 8TH GRADE STUDENTS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS ABSENT 10%-20% OF THE TIME ENROLLED AT THE 7-WEEK MARK WITH 1 OR MORE "F'S" IN A CORE CLASS WILL DECREASE THE AVERAGE ABSENCE RATE BY 21%, FROM 12.7 TO 10.

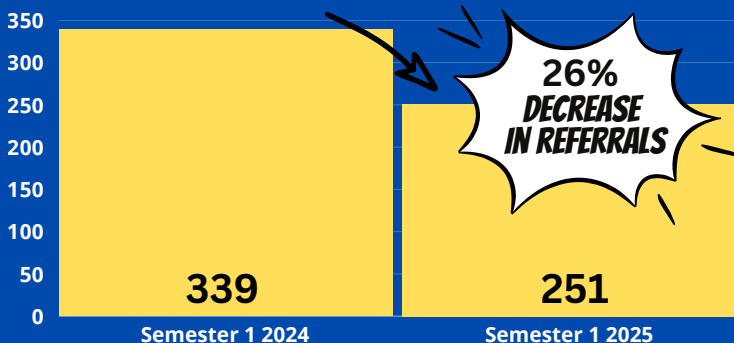

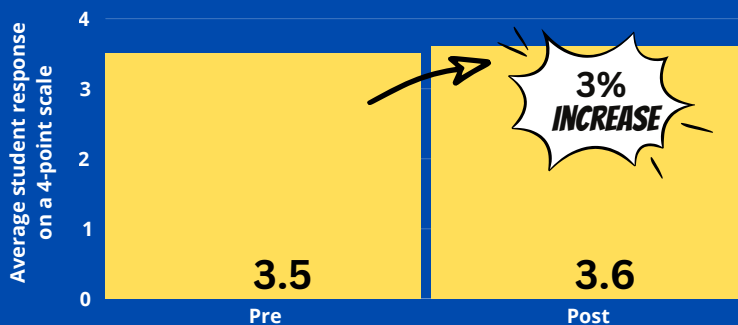
