## Aim for Reclassification!

Reclassification from English Learner (EL) to Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP) means a student has shown strong English skills based on California ELPAC results and other school measures. This important milestone builds confidence, allows access to more academic opportunities, and helps students stay on track for graduation and future college or career goals. Reclassification does not mean support ends, schools continue to monitor progress and provide help when needed.
