The February 10, 2026 measures continue funding that benefits every student in the district.

The measures ensure access to the programs, technology, and facilities that support safe schools, strong teaching and opportunities for all.



EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS LEVY RENEWAL

This levy renews funding for student programs and operations not funded by the state. It supports **16% of our district's overall operating budget** and includes:

-  **Student Programs**
-  **Athletics, Art & Extracurricular Activities**
-  **Early Learning**
-  **Additional Course Offerings**
-  **School Staff**
-  **Professional Learning**

SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY AND CAPITAL PROJECTS LEVY RENEWAL

This levy continues our investment in the district's technology and technology training programs to support innovative learning. It also renews funding for building updates:

-  **Technology to support student learning**
-  **Site improvements, athletic and lighting systems**
-  **Safety and security systems**
-  **Classroom technology and interactive displays**
-  **Repairs and updates to HVAC systems, building and sustainability improvements**
-  **Technology infrastructure**

PROPOSITION

2

These levies stay in our community and directly support Lake Washington students. The levies expire after four years and must be renewed by voters to continue the funding. Historically, the individual tax rate has decreased as more properties are built in our community or as property values increase.

The tax rate for these two measures is estimated to be \$1.43 per \$1,000 of assessed property value in 2027, decreasing to \$1.36 per \$1,000 of assessed property value by 2030.
