 - Includes a comprehensive information on the performance of students in each district and campus in the state
 - Performance is shown disaggregated by student groups, including ethnicity and socioeconomic status
 - Provides extensive information on school and district staff, programs, and student demographics

 - Reported for
 - Each Assessment
 - All Grades All Subjects
 - All Grades by Subject
- **STAAR – Academic Growth – reported for 2025 and 2024**
 - Only calculated in Reading (Grades 4-8, English I, and English II) and Math (Grades 4-8 and Algebra I)
 - Reported by Grade and Subject, as well as All Grades.
 - Accelerated Learning by Grade and Subject.
 - Students who did not pass in 2024 but achieved approaches or higher scores in 2025. This is based only on the grades and contents that we have growth metrics.

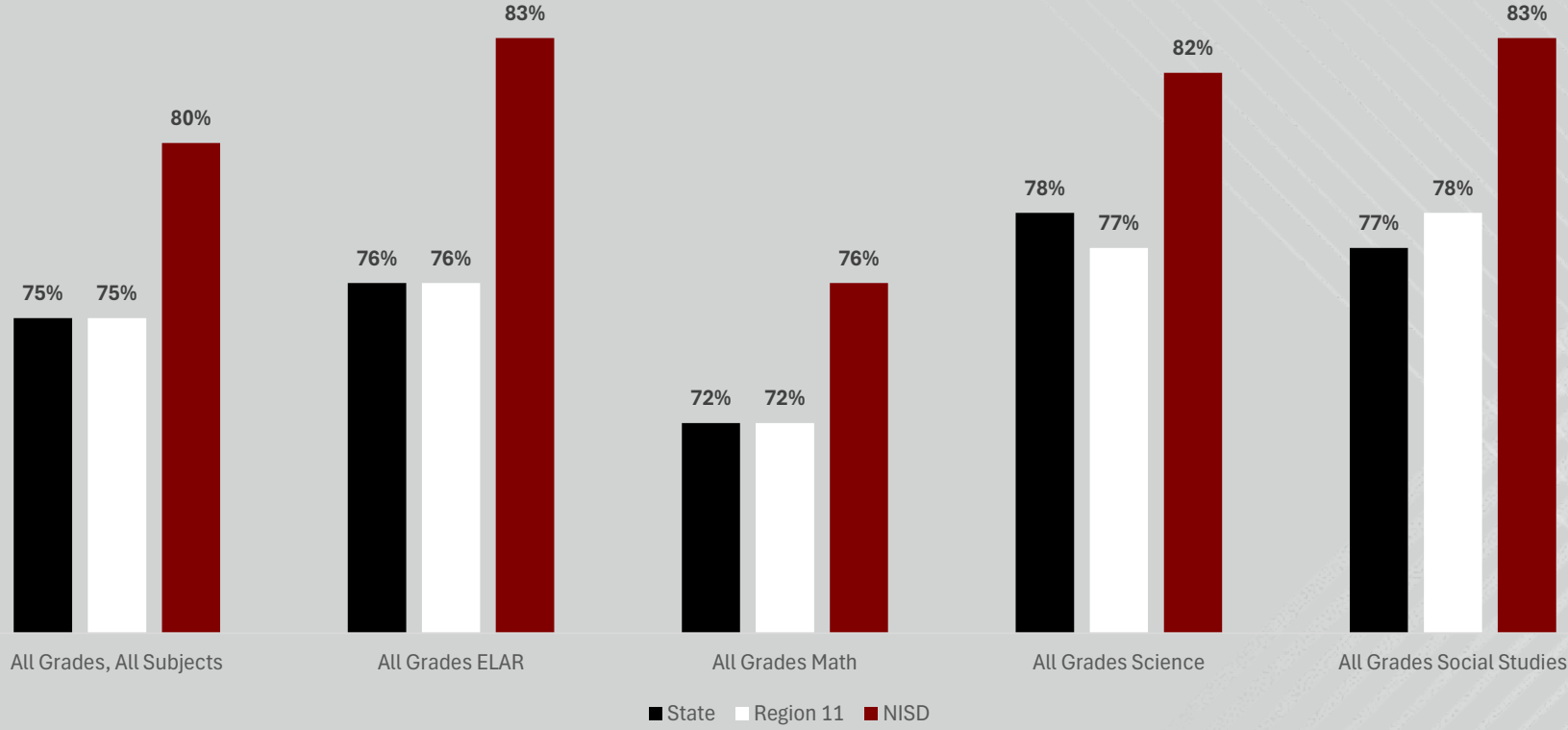

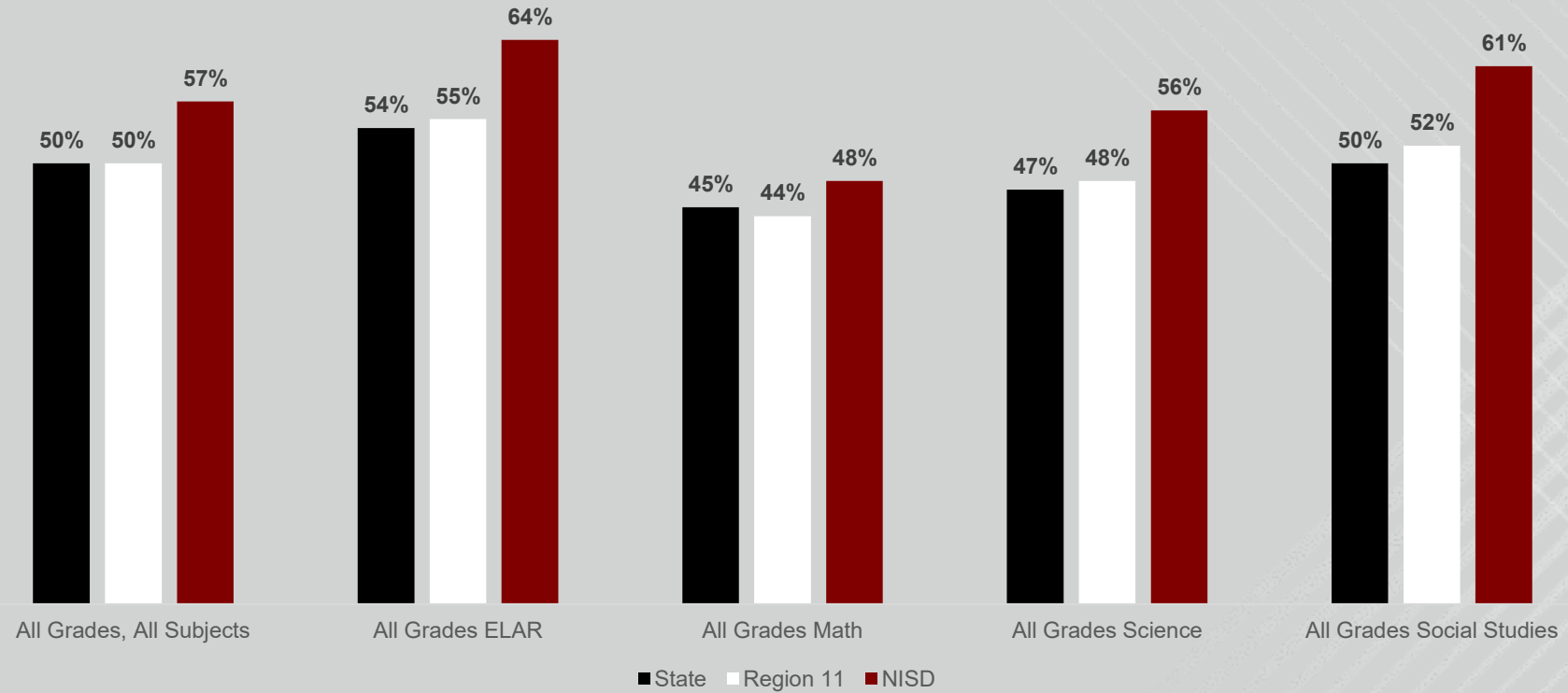
- 2024 – participation rate of 99%



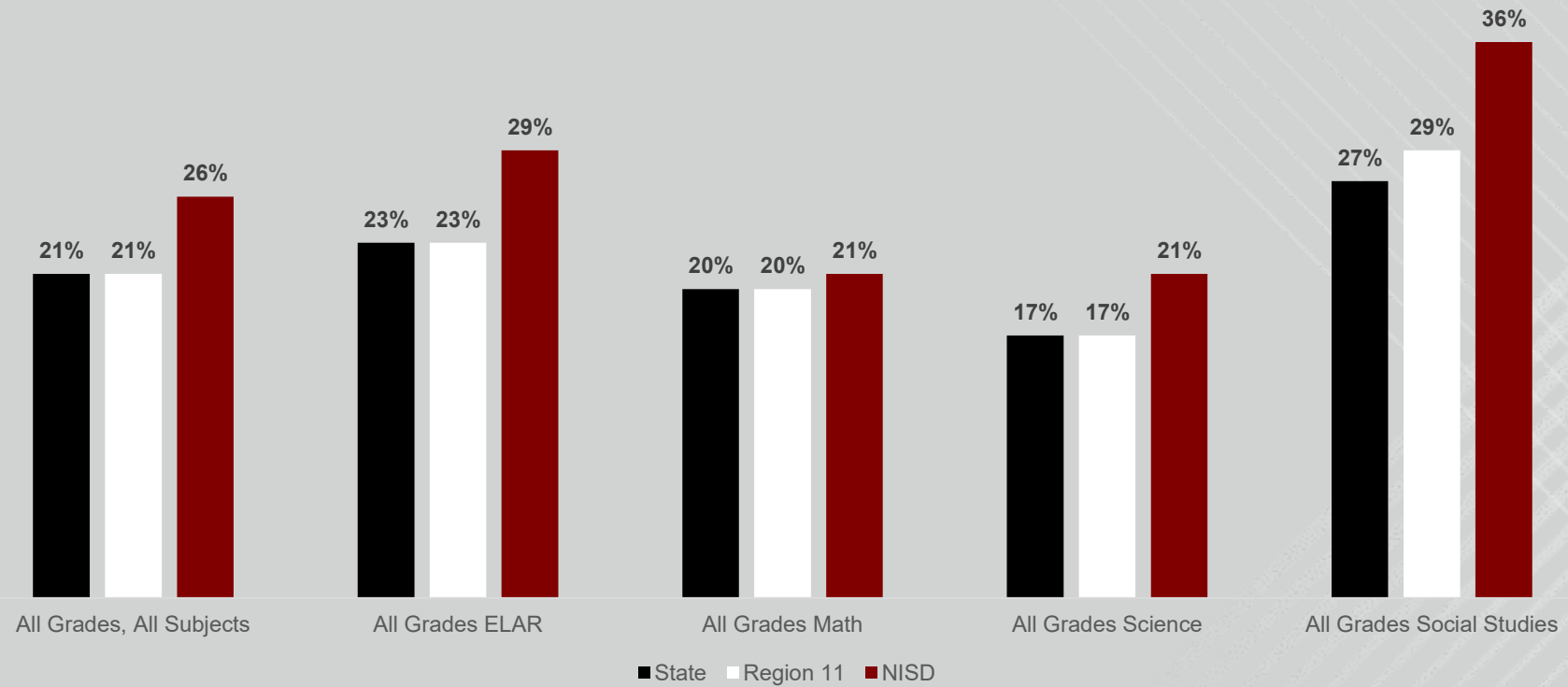
In 2025, NISD students consistently outperformed the state and Region XI across all content areas at the Approaches level or higher



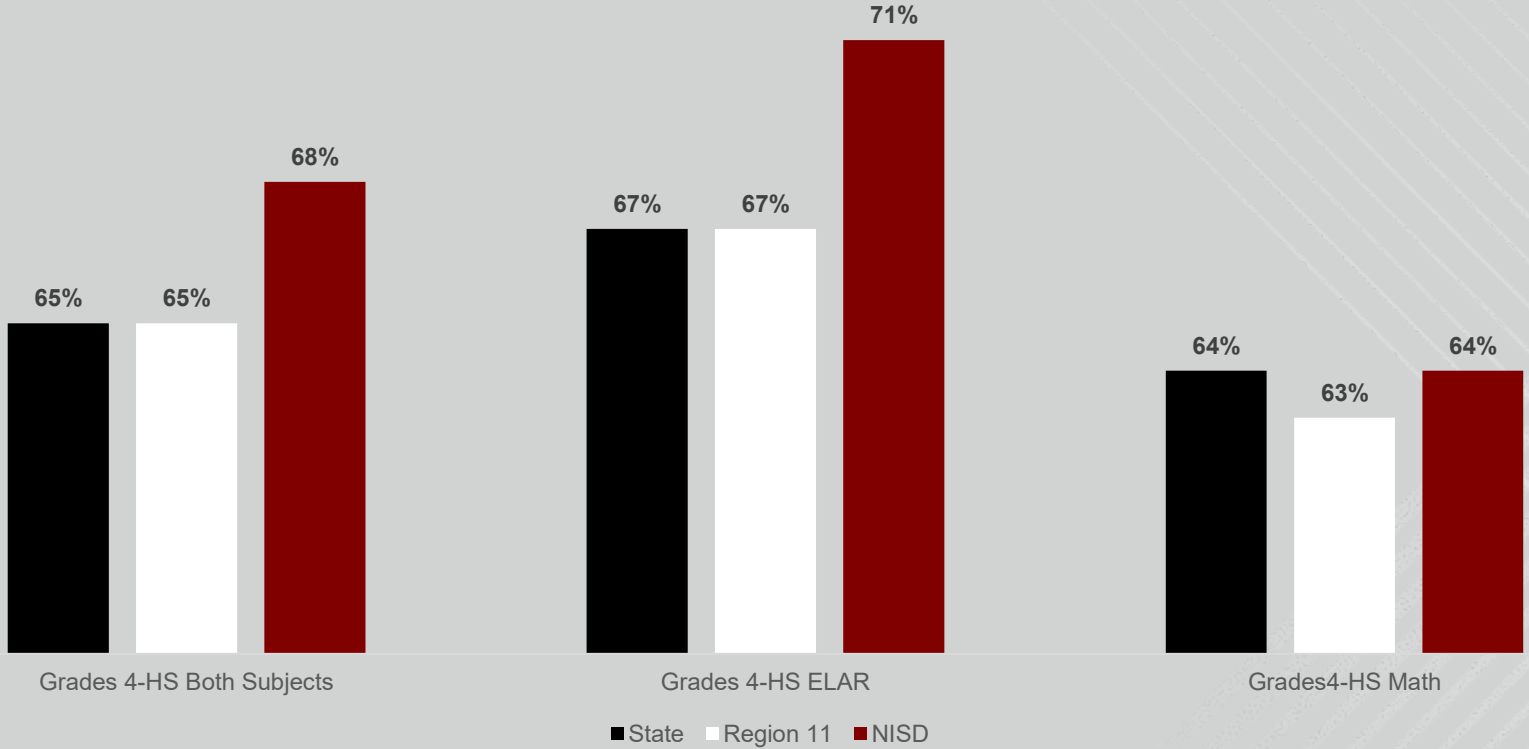
In 2025, NISD students exceeded state and Region XI performance across all content areas at the Meets level or higher



In 2025, NISD students demonstrated stronger performance than both the state and Region XI in all content areas at the Masters level or higher



In 2025, across grades 4–HS, NISD outperformed both the state and Region XI overall, with particularly strong performance in ELAR, and performance in math that met or exceeded regional and state levels

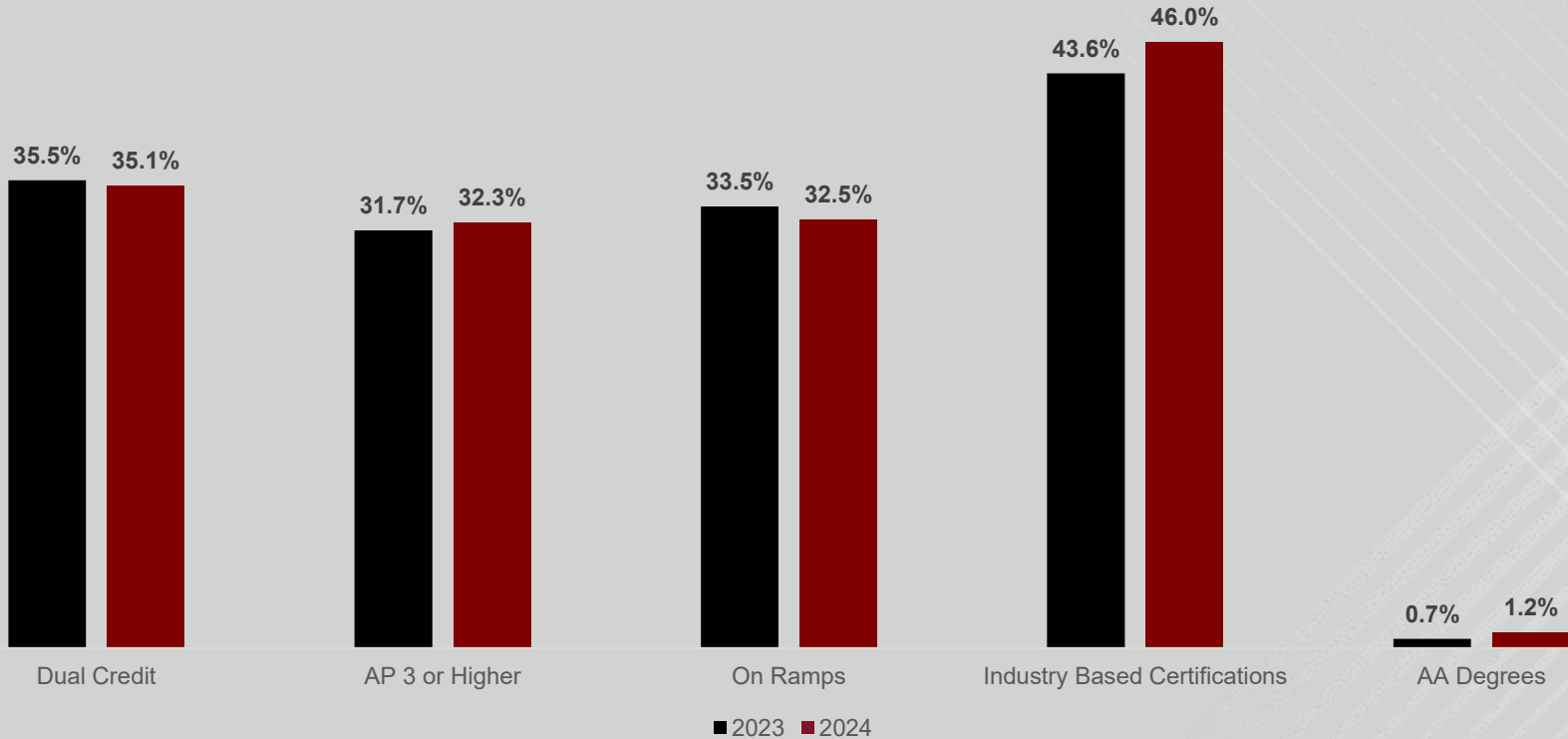

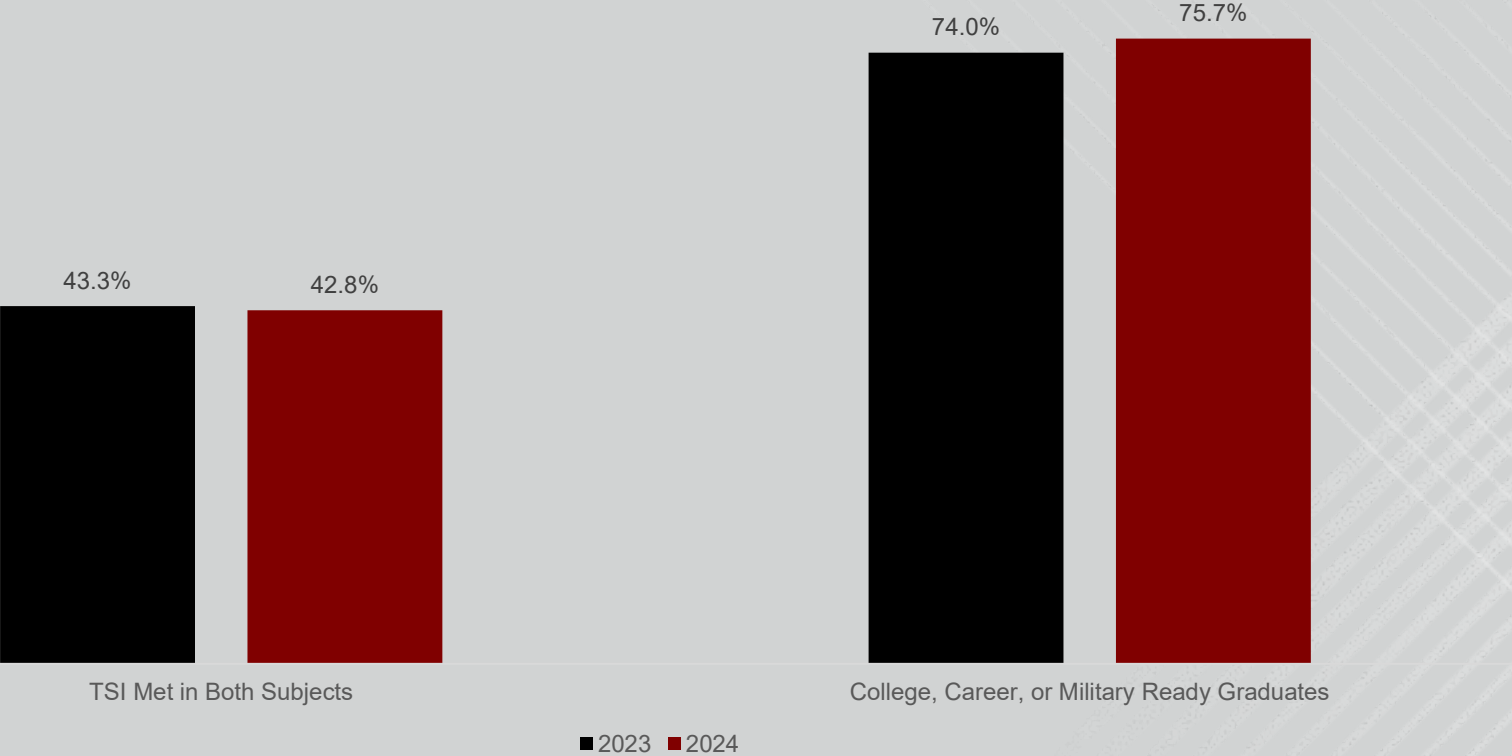

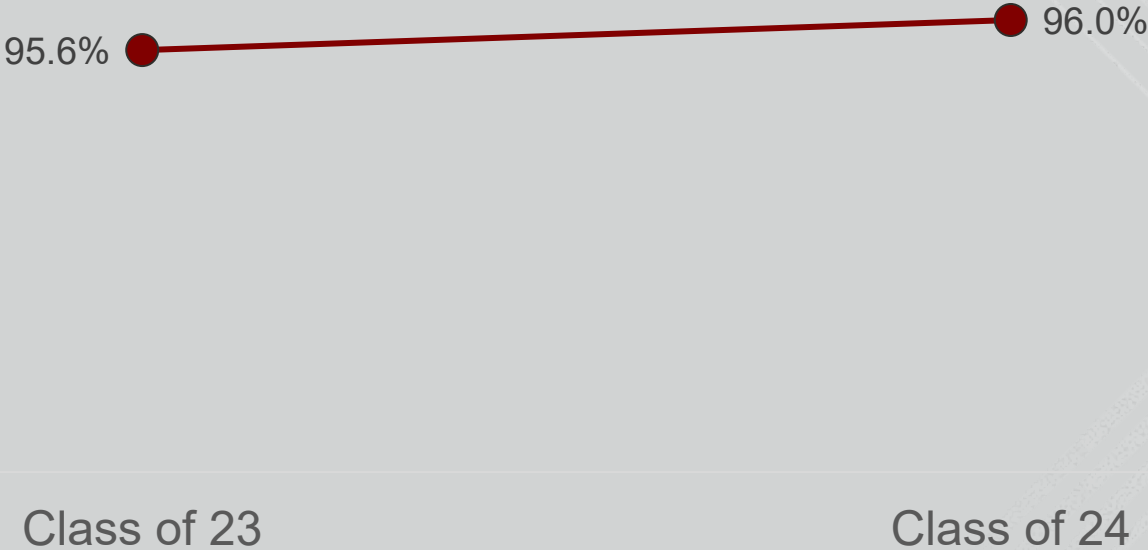
NISD demonstrated year-over-year growth in several CCMR indicators in 2024, including AP success, Industry-Based Certifications, and associate degree attainment



NISD increased the percentage of College, Career, or Military Ready graduates in 2024, marking continued momentum in postsecondary preparedness, alongside a small decrease in the percentage of students meeting TSI standards in both subjects



The four-year graduation rate rose to 96.0% for the Class of 2024



Dropout rates continue to decline in 2024

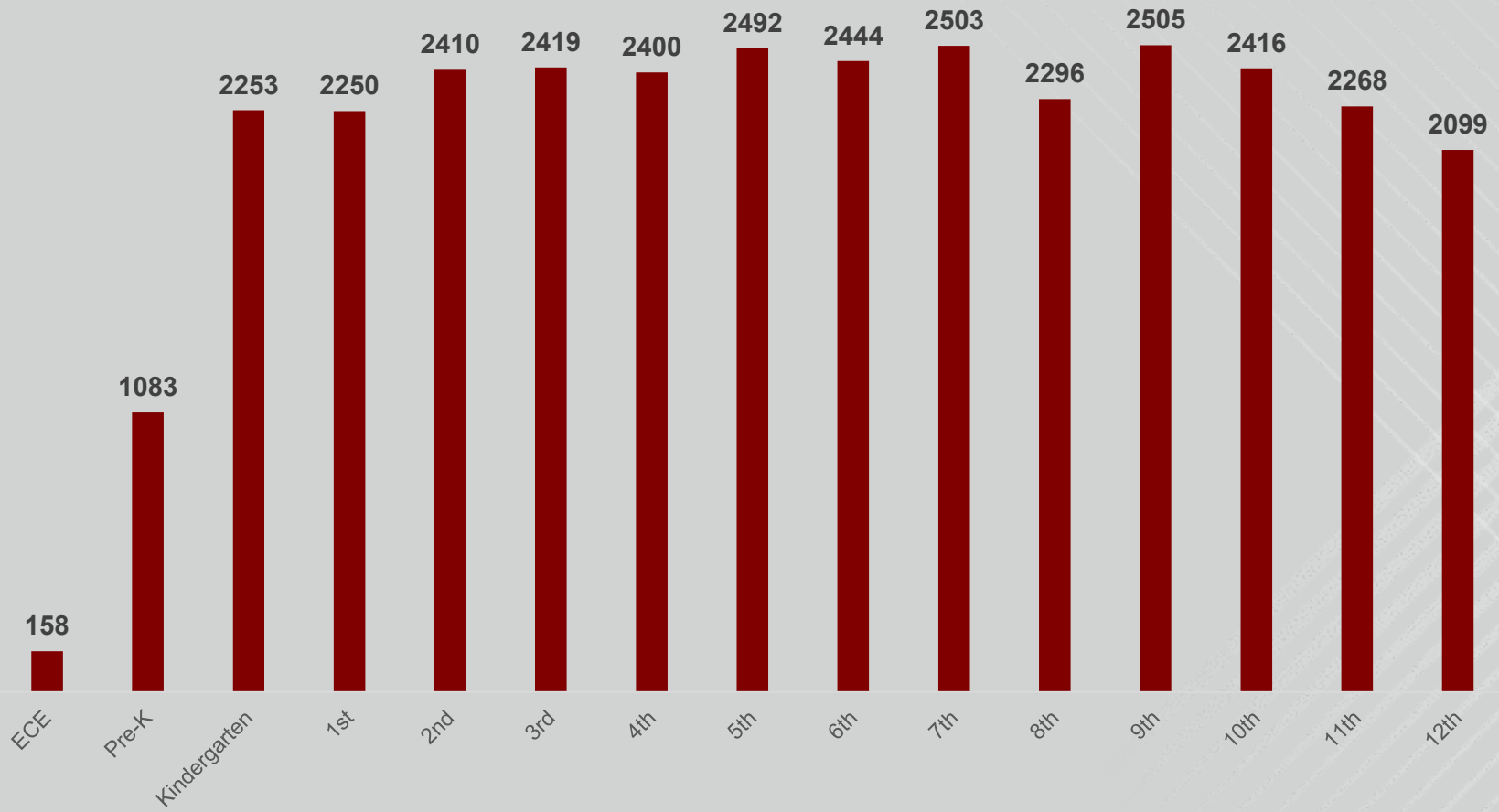

In 2025, NISD saw notable enrollment growth in Bilingual/ESL and Special Education programs, along with continued growth in Gifted and Talented services

What is the 2024-2025 District Accreditation Status?

- Generally, each year TEA assigns one of four accreditation statuses to each district in the state:
 1. *Accredited*
 2. *Accredited-Warned*
 3. *Accredited-Probation*
 4. *Not Accredited-Revoked*
- In assigning an accreditation status to a district, TEA considers
 - Academic accountability ratings
 - Financial accountability ratings
 - Data integrity
 - Program-area deficiencies identified through Results Driven Accountability (RDA)
- The District's 2023-2024 Accreditation Status is: **Accredited**

*** 22-23 is the most recent accreditation year.**

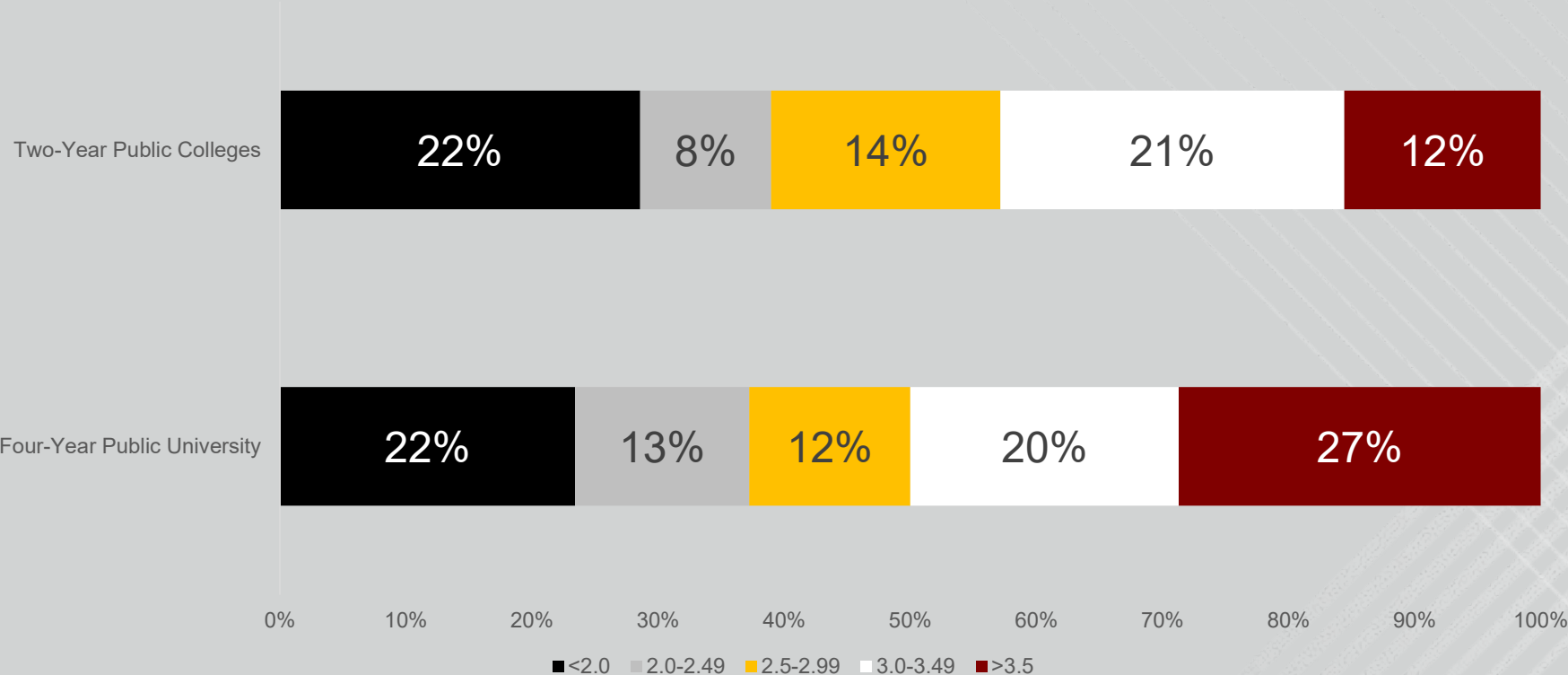

The most current year we have on student performance in Texas colleges is the Class of 2023. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board confirmed that 784 of 2,042 NISD Class of 2024 graduates attended a Texas two- or four-year college
