

## General Scheduling Notes:

- Review the Academic Programs and Pathways document for detailed course descriptions and other scheduling information.

Graded: Conventional	Grade: 10
Prerequisite: One credit each of Social Studies and English	
Time Frame: Year (4 mods/day)	

Most courses are 2 mods in length.

Courses/Programs that meet for more than 2 mods are indicated in the course descriptions in Academic Programs and Pathways document.

Some classes are full year, while others are a semester.

Some courses have required prerequisite coursework. You will not be able to request the course in Infinite Campus without having taken the prerequisite courses listed.

- Selecting Early Release or Late Arrival is only available to seniors who are on-track to graduate.
- Please consider your requests carefully. Once your schedule has been finalized, it may not be possible to make a change because classes are filled.
- If you are a new or returning IB Diploma Program student, enter the code "IB DIPLOMA" in the "non-credit" area of the Course Plan in Infinite Campus

## Virtual Courses:

- 9th and 10th graders** are limited to two virtual course periods with only one being a core course (ELA, SS, Science, Math).
- 11th and 12th graders** are limited to 50% of their schedule as DCS Virtual coursework and only one of these can be a core course (ELA, SS, Science, Math).
- A student with 5 classes may take 2 of these virtually.
- A student with 6 or 7 classes may take 3 of these virtually.

## Maintaining a Full Courseload:

### Minimum course requirements:

- A student taking only DCS classes must schedule **at least** 10 mods of graded coursework.
- A student taking a mix of DCS & CCP courses should schedule one of the following (**minimum**):
  - 1 CCP course per semester & 4 DCS HS credits
  - 2 CCP courses per semester & 3 DCS HS credits
  - 3 CCP courses per semester & 1 DCS HS credit
- A full time CCP student is taking 4 CCP courses per semester (or an equivalent of 12 college credits) and is not required to take DCS courses.

### Course requests in Infinite Campus:

- Additional steps are required to be completed yearly to qualify for College Credit Plus. [See the district website for CCP requirements](#)
- In the "non-credit" area of the Course Plan in Infinite Campus, students taking CCP coursework will enter the appropriate course codes mentioned below.
