Ali Ghandour Center for Leadership, Diversity and Civic Engagement

Established in 2019, the Ali Ghandour Center for Leadership, Diversity, and Civic Engagement (AGC) marks the first community-based learning center of its kind at the secondary school level in the region.

Jointly funded by IC and the Ghandour family, the AGC offers a scholarship and an intensive leadership and dynamic citizenship program through a Community Engaged Learning (CEL) model. In addition to completing IC's academic requirements, recipients of AGC scholarship are expected to commit to the AGC three-year extra-curricular program. This program mentors students through a sequenced journey, beginning with extensive capacity-building training and volunteer experience with grassroots organizations and culminating in student-led Community Service Projects (CSPs).

The program also exposes enrolled students to national, regional, and international speaker events, training programs, and competitions in a wide range of fields, among them social entrepreneurship, project design, and public speaking, with the aim of providing students with the skills and tools to become active agents of change.

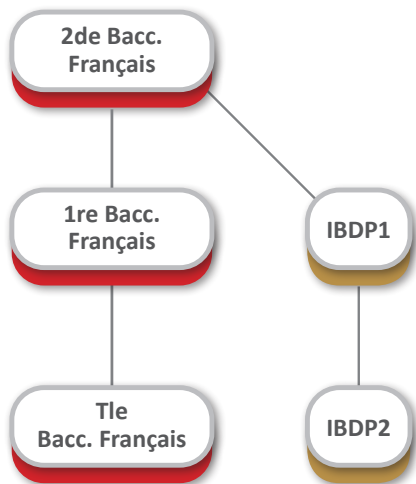
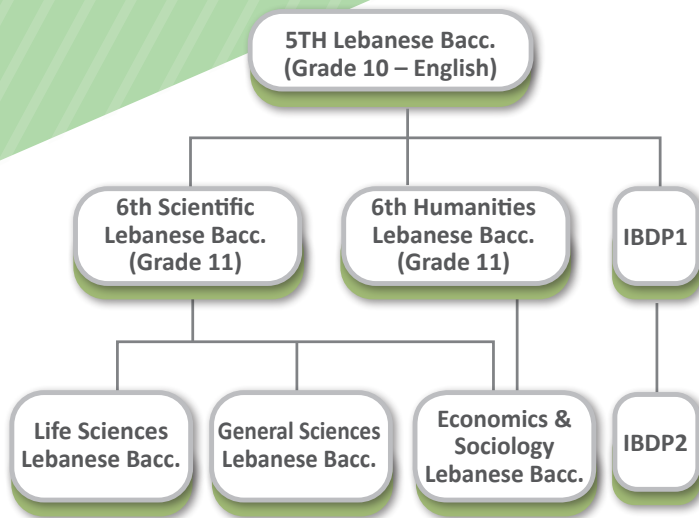

Program Choices



The AGC Scholarship Eligibility



AGC scholarship will cover all tuition fees, books, uniforms, and transportation within the Beirut area for the student's three years of enrollment at the high school.

The applicant is expected to:

- Have been enrolled in Lebanese public or subsidized schools for the previous 2 years
- Have excellent academic records for grade 8 and grade 9 (16/20 and above)
- Prove high financial need, based on a detailed financial aid application
- Meet IC academic enrollment requirements.
- Demonstrate leadership potential, social awareness, and commitment to the extracurricular milestones of the scholarship program.
- Have achieved higher than 16/20 on the "Brevet" (Grade 9) national exams.

Application Process



1. Deadline for submitting application is **April 14, 2026.**

2. Eligible applicants will sit for IC entrance exam on **May 18 & 19, 2026.**

3. Shortlisted applicants will sit for an interview (date to be assigned). A home visit will follow.

Required Documents*



1. Copy of Lebanese Identity Card
2. Copy of report cards for the academic years 2024–2025 and 2025–2026 (1st semester).
3. Statement from the principal of the last school attended regarding character and academic status.
4. One passport photo.
5. Employment certificate obtained from the employer for both parents- if applicable.
6. Documentation of annual income, business registration (سجل تجاري) and income tax statements If the parent is self-employed.
7. Copy of family civil record – إخراج قيد عائلي
8. School Certificates of annual fees for each dependent child enrolled at a university/ college or a school.
9. Copies of recent relevant documents pertaining to assets and liabilities (e.g. mortgage, loan agreements, car registration forms, etc.)
10. Photocopy of the recent rental contract (عقد ايجار) and/or ownership deed(s) (سندات ملكية) of a house, land, and/or business premises.
11. Any additional documentation that would support the application for the scholarship (e.g. medical reports and recent termination, etc.)

* The above documents in hard copies are to be submitted by hand to the AGC Office at IC- High School, within two weeks after filling out the application form online on IC website www.ic.edu.lb/admissions/apply.
