Talk with your teachers:


Get their professional recommendation on what course would be your best choice.

Think about your future:


What courses could you take that allow you to explore career ideas?



Where do I go to request courses?


How do I get to Course Planner, & what do I do once I am there?


Log in to your SchooLinks account using your Google Log-In. Click the “plan” icon, then “course planner”.

Then, click “let’s go”.







Confirming Teacher Recommendations

Honors or Advanced Placement courses for English, Math and Science require a teacher recommendation. Prior to you selecting your courses, your teacher will enter their recommendation into SchoolLinks in the Comments section.

- If your request aligns with their recommendation, you simply request the honors/AP course in your course plan.
 - (ex: Honors English 9 recommended, you plan to take Honors English 9)
- If your request does not align with their recommendation and you want to take a non-Honors or non-AP Course, simply select the regular level course.
 - (ex: Honors Biology recommended, you plan to take Biology. add Bio)
- If your request does not align with their recommendation and you want to take an Honors or AP course without recommendation, request your course of interest and speak with your counselor.






How do I pick my sequence & course?



Cancel Submit with errors Fix course plan

Once you hit submit, you will likely have “course plan errors” which denote unfulfilled requirements or requirements for which you have not yet planned.

Review what is listed but know that if you have not planned for all future years of high school, you WILL have errors. It is okay to submit with errors.

If you notice you have forgotten something, you are able to go back and “fix” errors which will allow you to adjust your requests.

If selecting a course that requires teacher recommendation, confirm that you have received the required recommendation from your teacher.
