


2016 APS CCRPI Data Report

The Georgia Department of Education released 2016 CCRPI results on December 8th. The district overall score decreased 1.8 points from 67.0 to 65.2. Similarly, the overall score for the state of Georgia fell 1.9 points from 75.5 to 73.6.

Figure 1 shows that the decline in APS scores from 2015 and 2016 is due primarily to a decrease in Progress points, which declined in each grade band.

Single-year changes in school-level CCRPI scores are typically temporary fluctuations, as opposed to representative of long term trends. Because of this, the tables in sections two and three below are sorted by three-year averages. This document is composed of three parts:

Section 1: CCRPI District Trends (pages 2-4) – This section shows changes by cluster and district progress percentages by grade and subject.

Section 2: CCRPI Scores for the Past Three Years (pages 5-9) – These tables report scores as reported from GADOE; scores are not combined to show effects of current and planned mergers. For schools that cross grade levels, both the grade-level score and the single score (which combines grade levels) are reported in separate tables.


Section 3: CCRPI Progress Percentages for the Past Three Years (pages 10-13) – These tables report scores as reported from GADOE; scores are not combined to show the effects of current and planned mergers.

Section 1: District Trends

Figure 2 below shows each cluster’s average CCRPI and change from 2015. The Jackson cluster made the largest gain, while Mays and Washington clusters had the largest declines.

Figure 2: Average CCRPI Scores by Cluster and Change from 2015*



Section 1: District Trends (continued)


Figure 3: Percentage of Students Making Typical or High Growth by Subject over Time, EOG.

Figure 3 below shows elementary and middle school progress percentages by grade and subject over time. Across all grades, ELA had the highest percentage of students making typical or high growth at 64%. Both ELA and math had a five point decrease compared to 2015. Fifth grade science was a relative strength at 67%, while eighth grade math had the smallest percentage of students achieving typical or high growth at 52%.

Figure 4 shows high school progress percentages by exam. Biology had both the largest gain (+2%) and largest percentage of students making progress (65%). Ninth grade literature both had the largest decline (-20%) and lowest percentage (52%).

Section 3: Tables of CCRPI Progress Percentages for the Past Three Years

CCRPI progress scores are based on the percentage of students making typical or high growth. The state average is 65%.

Elementary school progress points measure growth in 4th and 5th grade, which is only one third of an elementary school. Use this data alongside the district’s Milestones vs Challenge graphs for a more complete picture of a school.
