
MINUTES OF THE MILLVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 6, 2026

The Millville Area School Board held a special meeting on Tuesday, January 6, 2026 in the Millville Jr./Sr. High School Library beginning 7:00 pm.

1. ROLL CALL

The following Board members answered roll call: Alex Cavallini, Michael Farrell, Heather Mausteller, Jonathan Richards, Corey Whitmoyer, and Jessica Whitmoyer.

Also present were Joseph Rasmus, Superintendent of Schools; Matt Mills, Secondary Principal; Brandon Gordner, Elementary Principal; Matthew McWilliams, Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds; Dyson Savage, Director of Technology; and Chelsea Rosenberger, Board Recording Secretary.

2. GUEST RECOGNITION AND COMMENTS

Guest Wendy Faatz signed the register but did not request to speak.

3. PERSONNEL

3.1 Termination - Employee 1109

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Michael Farrell that the Millville Area School Board consider and approve the termination of employee 1109, effective immediately. The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.2 Appoint School Social Worker

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Alex Cavallini that the Millville Area School Board consider and approve appointing KERA LABONTE, as School Social Worker at Masters Step 7, with commensurate salary per the collective bargaining agreement. Pending receipt of all necessary documentation.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.3 Appoint Health Room Assistant/LPN

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Michael Farrell that the Millville Area School Board consider and approve appointing ABBIE MYERS, as the HEALTH ROOM ASSISTANT/LPN at the rate of \$23 per hour. Pending receipt of all necessary documentation.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.4 Appoint Second Shift Custodian

A motion by Michael Farrell and second by Heather Mausteller that the Millville Area School Board consider and approve appointing STEVEN CONFER, as a SECOND SHIFT CUSTODIAN at the rate of \$13.55 per hour, inclusive of the second shift differential. Pending receipt of all necessary documentation.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.5 Appoint Paraprofessional

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Michael Farrell that the Millville Area School Board consider and approve appointing CYNTHIA AMADO, as a Paraprofessional at the rate of \$12.15 per hour. Pending receipt of all necessary documentation.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.6 Interim School Psychological Services - A. Longacre

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Alex Cavallini that the Millville Area School Board appoint ALEXA LONGACRE to undertake contracted responsibilities of interim school psychological services for an hourly compensation of \$75 per hour. The Interim School Psychologist is required to maintain professional liability insurance for the duration of services.

- Mr. Farrell asked if the district had an estimated start date for Dr. Meadows to in his new position.
- Dr. Rasmus answered that Dr. Meadows believed he would start in mid-February so the time for these services would be short.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

3.7 Interim School Psychological Services - J. Meadows

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Michael Farrell that the Millville Area School Board appoint DR. JAMES MEADOWS to undertake contracted responsibilities of interim school psychological services to be compensated at a rate of \$1500 per psychoeducational evaluation. The Interim School Psychologist is required to maintain professional liability insurance for the duration of services.

- Mrs. Mausteller asked how long it takes to complete an evaluation.
- Dr. Rasmus answered that it can take anywhere from 15 to 25 hours, depending on the needs of the student. He added that this fee was standard for Dr. Meadows working at other schools as well.
- Mrs. Mausteller asked for clarity as to whether or not this agreement would end once Dr. Meadows starts in the district in the role.
- Dr. Rasmus answered that yes, this interim services agreement would end once Dr. Meadows began his position in the district.

The motion carried by roll call vote. 6 Yes; 0 No; 3 Absent

4. ADJOURNMENT

A motion by Heather Mausteller and second by Michael Farrell to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
