Dear Celina ISD Families,

The following statement was read at the conclusion of last night's School Board Meeting:

"The Board received an extremely large amount of information with the investigative report. The Board will review all of the information and evaluate all appropriate actions stemming from the findings. The Board will meet again on January 20th to continue its discussion to ensure a thorough review.

"In addition, the District is in the process of preparing the report to disclose as much of the report as possible to provide transparency to the community regarding the findings. However, Chapter 21 of the Texas Education Code requires confidentiality regarding evaluative information of Chapter 21 certified employees. Additionally, the District will take measures to ensure the confidentiality of witness identities and/or other information confidential under the Texas Public Information Act. The District will be as transparent as the law and confidentiality concerns will allow and will work to release the redacted report by the end of the week."

Celina ISD appreciates the continued patience and engagement of our families and community as this process moves forward. Our District remains steadfast in our commitment to the safety, trust, and well-being of every student. Celina is a community that faces challenges together, supports one another, and grows stronger through open communication and care. Our commitment to these priorities will not change.
