An explanation of the appropriate methods for recognizing tasks and other activities that may involve exposure to blood and other potentially infectious materials.

An explanation of the use and limitations of methods that will prevent or reduce exposure, including appropriate engineering controls, work practices, and personal protective equipment.

Information on the types, proper use, location, removal, handling, decontamination, and disposal of personal protective equipment.

An explanation of the basis for selection of personal protective equipment.

Information on the Hepatitis B vaccine: efficacy, safety, method of administration, benefits, offered free of charge to employee.

Post-exposure procedures, evaluations, and follow-up.

Explanation of the signs, labels, and color coding.

Opportunity for interactive questions and answers with person conducting the training session.
