

DRESS AND PERSONAL GROOMING STAFF

Recognizing the many different dress and grooming tastes among its professional staff, it is the policy of the Bethel Board of Education that principals will dress in the appropriate fashion to maintain the professional image and encourage all school personnel to dress appropriately to reflect pride and professionalism.

The board also feels that the faculty members are professional people and their dress should be a compliment to the profession and a positive example for the students and the community.

Certain teaching and support positions can require exceptions being made by site administrators. Physical Education teachers, Vo-Ag teachers, coaches and custodians all fall into this possible exception. At all times a professional look will be expected, even when an administrator grants an exception.

The building administrator may approve jeans and/or spirit-wear for special occasions (spirit day, field trip, or special classroom activities requiring more casual attire). Administrators will attempt to limit these occasions to once per week as a general rule.

The administration shall be held responsible for interpreting and implementing these regulations.
