Wilma Maiers was the epitome of a community-engaged leader and had a special love for the town of Summerville, while serving through the Kiwanis Club. In honor of her dedication and spirit, the following Memorial Scholarship seeks to support local talent as our town's treasure!

The Kiwanis Club of Summerville, SC will honor one graduating senior from each of the three Dorchester County District Two High Schools by granting a One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000) non-renewable scholarship, known as the Wilma Maiers Memorial Scholarship. Once the scholarship recipient is selected, funds will be made available to the selected students upon proof of enrollment at any two- or four-year institution of higher learning, college or university.

The Scholarship will be presented at either the Awards night at each respective school or at a Kiwanis meeting. The scholarship recipient will be notified of the award of the scholarship and invited to appear to receive the award.
