

## **VALEDICTORIAN & SALUTATORIAN SELECTION**

The valedictorian and salutarian shall be selected from the senior class. The student with the highest GPA shall be declared as valedictorian; the student with the second highest GPA will be declared as salutarian. The grade point will be determined by carrying out the average to the nearest one thousandth and rounded off to the nearest one-hundredth on the weighted grade point scale.

For determination of valedictorian, and salutarian, the GPA will be determined at the conclusion of the first semester of the student's senior year. The recognized valedictorian and salutarian, as determined by this policy, shall be honored at the commencement exercises and shall give the valedictory and salutatory addresses.

For scholarship purposes, student who earn a 4.0 GPA. or greater, using the weighted scale, shall be eligible to be named co-valedictorians. How many of these students are eligible for valedictorian scholarships will be at the discretion of the various colleges and universities based on their policies and procedures.
