

VEHICLE USE AND PARKING STUDENTS

The Bethel Board of Education will permit student use and parking of motor vehicles on the high school campus only. Students driving a motor vehicle to the high school campus may park the vehicle only in the parking lot designated for student parking. Students will not park vehicles in the parking lot(s) designated for staff and visitors. The vehicle will not be used during the school day. In the event of an emergency, permission may be granted for a student's use of a vehicle.

Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right. The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of student automobiles when on school property. The interior of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has a reasonable suspicion that illegal or unauthorized materials may be contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without consent, and without a search warrant. All student drivers must provide a photocopy of their drivers license to be placed on file in the build-level administrators office.
