The Toothmobile is visiting the Winola Grade School on March 27<sup>th</sup> 2026!

This is a great opportunity to have your child receive preventive dental care and meet the STATE LAW requirement that ALL K, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> GRADERS HAVE A MANDATED DENTAL EXAM!

The Toothmobile is a mobile dentist office with a licensed dentist completing the exam. All preventative care (such as exams and cleanings) that can be completed in a traditional dentist office is available on the Toothmobile. They do not however fill cavities or remove teeth. A referral may be made for further treatments if tooth decay is present.

All students are welcome and encouraged to participate in the clinic. As a reminder, this EXAM FULFILLS THE STATE LAW REQUIRING ALL K, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 6<sup>TH</sup> and 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADERS TO HAVE A MANDATED DENTAL EXAM.

**A medical card covers ALL the cost of services once a year.** Commercial dental insurance will be billed. If you do not have dental insurance, please contact the MCHD and ask for Steph.
