April 17th 2026



The Toothmobile is a mobile dentist office with a licensed dentist completing the exam. All preventative care (such as exams and cleanings) that can be completed in a traditional dentist office is available on the Toothmobile. They do not however fill cavities or remove teeth. A referral may be made for further treatments if tooth decay is present.

All students are welcome and encouraged to participate in the clinic. As a reminder, this EXAM FULFILLS THE STATE LAW REQUIRING ALL K, 2ND, 6TH and 9TH GRADERS TO HAVE A MANDATED DENTAL EXAM.

A medical card covers ALL the cost of services once a year. Commercial dental insurance will be billed. If you do not have dental insurance, please contact the MCHD and ask for Steph.
