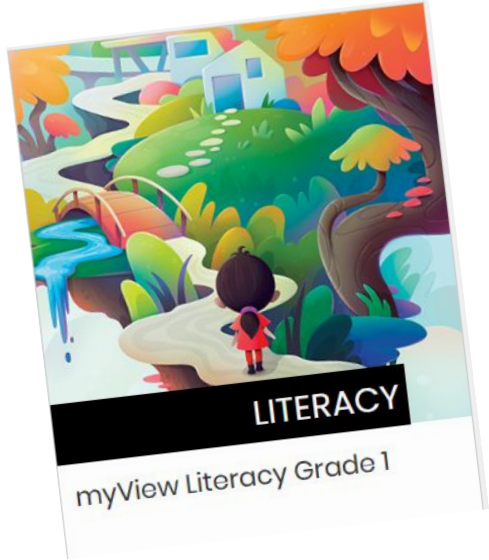


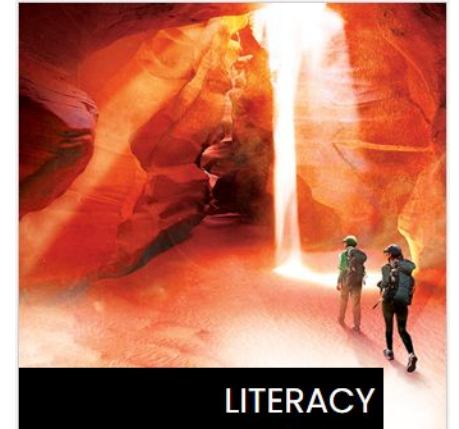

PEC Noticings



- Compared to the Fall of 2024:
 - Kindergarteners performed 5% points higher in 2025- this may be due to the newly aligned UPK curriculum- 3 Cheers for Pre-K!
 - First Graders performed the same.
 - Second Graders performed 2% points higher.
- A data driven action planning protocol model is used to discuss growth & opportunities with Peer Coordinators.
- The data informs WINN blocks . Lancer Learning Time & flexible student reading groups

IEC Noticings



- Performance across grades 3-5 shows consistency from last year, reflecting stability in instruction and curriculum alignment.
 - a. **3rd Grade**
 - i. **Grade Level Average:** 59%
Last Year's Average: 59%
 - b. **4th Grade**
 - i. **Grade Level Average:** 61%
Last Year's Average: 62%
 - c. **5th Grade**
 - i. **Grade Level Average:** 64%
Last Year's Average: 67%
- SPED classrooms remain within a reasonable range of their grade-level averages, showing effective differentiation and support.
- Continued emphasis on explicit reading strategies, vocabulary instruction, and student engagement with complex texts will be essential for midyear growth.

Next Steps:

- Review individual and class-level MyView data reports to identify standard-specific strengths and needs at PLC.
- Schedule midyear data review in February to monitor student progress and instructional impact.
