

AGRICULTURE



Montana agricultural education in 2020-21 had **94 approved programs** with **7,452 students**.

These programs include co-curricular FFA chapters with **90 chapters** and **4,376 members**.

INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY

Industrial Technology had **98 programs** and **17,455 students** in 2020-21.

Montana has two Career and Technical Student Organizations for the Industrial Technology area. SkillsUSA has **240 members** and **23 chapters**, and Technology Student Association (TSA) has **698 members** in **7 chapters**.



HEALTH SCIENCE



Health Science Education in 2020-21 had **27 approved programs** and they served **3,802 students** around the state.

The student organization associated with Health Sciences is HOSA - Future Health Professionals. Montana had **19 HOSA chapters** with **400 student members** in 2020-21.



BUSINESS EDUCATION



141 of Montana's public high schools had approved Business Education programs in 2020-21, making it the most-offered CTE program in the state. These programs served **23,880 students**.

Montana has two Career and Technical Student Organizations for Business Education programs: Business Professionals of America (BPA) with **1,225 members** in **88 chapters**, DECA with **302 members** and **12 chapters**.

Montana had **93 approved FCS programs** in 2020-21 serving **13,753 students**.

Family, Career and Community Leaders of America is the only student organization with family as its central focus. In 2020-21, Montana had **60 FCCLA chapters** with over **863 members**.
