




2026-2027 Boundary Transition Update

January 12, 2026

Purpose of Tonight's Update



- Provide details on the classroom moving logistics for the summer of 2026.
- Provide an update regarding progress on transportation routing.



Student Assignment Update

- All students have been assigned to schools based on new boundaries and program placements for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Families received communication of their school assignment in November 2025.
- We received 294 residency exception requests and we approved 197 and denied 97.
- Families may still make requests by contacting the Office of Schools.
- Requests will be considered based on space availability.



Classroom Moving Logistics

- Principals received guidance for identifying classroom spaces on November 24, 2025.
- Principals participated in staffing meetings to determine staffing numbers between December 2, 2025, and December 12, 2025.
- Principals met with their School Department Committees to finalize classroom assignments for the 2026-2027 school year.



Classroom Moving Next Steps

- Room assignments were reviewed and finalized by a cross-functional central office team on January 5, 2026.
- An invitation to bid for moving vendors will be issued by mid-January.
- Bids will be reviewed and recommendations for vendors will be made to the Board of Education.
- Classroom moves will take place between May and August of 2026.



Transportation Routing Progress



- The Transportation Department has been working to determine most efficient routes based on new boundaries.
- The team is also reviewing potential adjustments to start and end times.
- Work is happening to make updates to transportation hazards to ensure the safety of students.
