## WHAT IS DISTANCE EDUCATION?

- ★ Distance Education involves a full-day of lessons that includes specials
- ★ Standards-based instruction
- ★ Whole group (all students together)
- ★ Small group
- ★ Wellness Checks/Social-emotional learning
- ★ Independent Learning Time
- ★ Distance Education is required by all students enrolled

## WHAT TIME?

- ★ School hours for students (K - 5) are still 9:00 am - 3:31 pm
- ★ PK students AM session: 9:00 am - 11:30 am (M-Thurs)
- ★ PK students PM session: 1:00 pm - 3:31 pm (M-Thurs)

## SCHEDULE

- ★ Grades Pre-K through 2 will have 60-90 minutes of synchronous (real-time) whole group learning per day.
- ★ Grades 3 through 5 will have 90-120 minutes of synchronous (real-time) whole group learning per day.
- ★ Time not spent on synchronous (real-time) whole group learning will be spent in small group or on asynchronous learning (structured/independent).
- ★ Students will have specials including PE, Music, Library, and Drama.
- ★ Individual Instructional Guides, with complete schedules, will be sent to every student!

## WILL THIS BE MORE WORK THAN "IN PERSON" SCHOOL?

- No...this will not be more work than "in person" school. We understand this is a whole new platform and we do not want students or families to feel overwhelmed.
- Synchronous (whole group) lessons will be recorded and may be viewed at another time.
- Students or families are not to take screenshots or record the sessions.

## ACADEMIC CONCERNS

- You may reach out to the teacher via district email, Canvas, or Class Dojo
- Contact the teacher first to help resolve an issue
- Administration is available via phone or email to help with concerns, as well
- All teachers will have virtual office hours at least two days per week
