Informational and Discussion Items:

1. Discussion Item: Principal's Update

- Admin began looking at vacancies for next year based on intent to return surveys
- CCRPI scores are available to share/view now.
 - Content Mastery – 98 Our school scored 90+ in all academic areas.
 - Progress – 93.6
 - Closing Gaps – 100 Almost all students and subgroups met annual achievement improvement targets.
 - Readiness – 94.5 - 90+ in all categories
 - Overall 96.1
- i-Ready Progress
 - 51% of students have achieved typical growth at mid-year and 21% have met stretch goal
 - 10% increase in students at mid or above grade level and 5% decrease in students at 2 or more grade levels below, 12% have met stretch goal in math.
- Attendance rate has improved from last year.



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- Behavior trends have improved based on fewer minor referrals, major incidents, OSS, and expulsions.
- Budget update – due to several challenges outside of FCS’s control, the development of 26-27 budget will be a challenging process. Our expected enrollment is higher than current which should put us in a better position to not lose a teacher. We will likely learn additional CTAE program dollars.
